With the Google toolbar, a free download from [toolbar.google.com](http://toolbar.google.com), you can search the whole site for the information that you want. It will highlight the words that you have searched for, making it easy to locate the appropriate matches.

The Google toolbar will also block annoying pop-up ads, fill forms in with one click, link a web log to the page or narrow your search to a specific country.
